Information For Parent Purchased Chromebooks

Purchasing a Chromebook:

Chromebooks can be purchased directly or through a monthly installment. An insurance premium has been included to address accidental damage/repairs.

Direct Pricing: \$300.00 (includes first year insurance premium)

Monthly Installment: \$37.50 for eight months (includes first year insurance premium) Monthly payments are made via School Cash Online at the start of each month from November 1 to June 1. Payments are automatically deducted with monthly receipts provided to parents.

Annual Insurance Premiums are indicated below at the cost of \$30 per year. Insurance covers damages and repair costs due to accidents. Loss and intentional abuse is not covered.

Students Leaving the School:

Students leaving their school for another Wolf Creek school will continue to be charged for payments during Year 1 and can continue using their Chromebook at their new school. Year 2 and Year 3 annual insurance premiums will continue.

Students leaving their school for a school <u>outside of Wolf Creek</u> will need to return the device, if they are still making payments in Year 1. Any payments up until the point where they leave, will be considered "rental" payments for use of the device up to the period they have left the school. Parents can contact School Cash Online to stop payments and the district will be asked to confirm the stop payment. All future payments after the first of the month will cease as the student is no longer enrolled in Wolf Creek. Students wishing to take their Chromebook with them to a school outside of Wolf Creek will need to ensure they have paid for the device in full, prior to leaving.

Warranty, Insurance, Repairing or Replacing Your Chromebook:

Wolf Creek Public Schools requires that insurance be purchased prior to the deployment of the parent/student owned Chromebook to your child. The insurance cost is \$30.00 annually for each Chromebook. The initial cost of the purchase of the device includes the \$30.00 for the first year.

Chromebooks Undergoing Repair:

- Loaner Chromebooks may be issued to students when they leave their Chromebook for repair with the school technology coach.
- If repair is needed due to malicious damage, the school may refuse to provide a loaner Chromebook.
- Repaired Chromebooks will end up with the original factory image as first received.
- Students and parents will be charged for Chromebook damage that is a result of misuse or abusive handling. Parents will be billed for parts and labor.

Acer Warranty:

Acer warranties the Chromebook from defects in materials and workmanship for a period of one year. This warranty is only valid for the first 12 months from the date Wolf Creek takes delivery of the Chromebook. This limited warranty covers normal use, mechanical breakdown, or faulty construction and will provide replacement parts necessary to repair or if necessary, replace the Chromebook. The Acer warranty <u>DOES NOT</u> warrant against damage caused by misuse, abuse, or accidents. Please report all Chromebook problems to the school teacher and/or technology coach.

If a Chromebook becomes defective (at no fault of the student) after the Acer warranty expires, Wolf Creek will replace the Chromebook at no charge with a refurbished Chromebook of the same age or newer.

Accidental Damage or Loss Protection:

As part of the 1:1 Chromebook project in Wolf Creek, Wolf Creek is requiring the purchase of accidental damage insurance prior to the deployment of the Chromebook to your child. Wolf Creek Public Schools will be the sole provider of this insurance. Under this insurance policy the Chromebooks are protected against accidental damage or loss due to an act of nature. Wolf Creek will require that a police report be submitted in cases of theft. Fraudulent reporting of theft will be turned over to the police for prosecution. A student making a false report will also be subject to disciplinary action as outlined by the school discipline code.

This insurance policy <u>does not</u> cover for loss of the Chromebook and/or its accessories, cosmetic damage, or damages caused by intentional misuse and abuse. Wolf Creek Technology Services will assess the Chromebook damage and repair or replace the device if the damage is determined to be accidental and within the protection guidelines. Parents/Students will be charged for full replacement cost of a device that has been damaged due to intentional misuse or abuse.

Making An Insurance Claim:

Each claim covered by insurance will be assessed an incremental deductible within the current school year. The first claim deductible will be \$30.00 with the deductible increasing by \$30.00 each time a claim is made within the current school year. If a student withdraws from Wolf Creek Public Schools and then re-enrolls later in the current school year, the coverage purchased at the student's initial registration will be reinstated along with the number of claims made prior to withdrawal.

Lost or Intentionally Damaged Device and Accessories:

A Chromebook or any of it's accessories that are lost (whereabouts unknown) or intentionally damaged is the responsibility of the student and parent involved in the loss of property. The user will not be given another device or accessory to use until the replacement cost of the lost/damaged device or accessory is paid to the school.

This will be due September 30 of each year. You will comply at all times with the Wolf Creek Public Schools Chromebook Policy Handbook and its guidelines as well as the Wolf Creek Code of Conduct and Technology Policies. The school may repossess the Chromebook if it has not been fully paid for in the event that policies or payments are not followed. Chromebooks are assigned to a single individual and are not to be shared.
P:	LOSS OR DAMAGE:
S:	 If the property is accidentally damaged or incurs loss due to an act of nature, Wolf Creek Public Schools will assess the Chromebook damage and repair or replace the device under the accidental loss or damage policy. If the property is stolen, a police report must be filed by the student or student's parents/guardian involved in the loss of property. Loss or theft of the property must be reported to the school by the next school day after the occurrence. Fraudulent reporting of theft will be turned over to the police for prosecution.
P: S:	PROPERTY RIGHTS OF CHROMEBOOK Your right to use and possession of the Chromebook terminates if your child is no longer enrolled in a Wolf Creek Public School with any remaining outstanding payments. All previous payments would be considered rental charges for use. Full payment can be made to allow the Chromebook to leave the district.
P: S:	 APPROPRIATION: Your failure to timely return the property and the continued use of it if your child is no longer enrolled in Wolf Creek Public Schools or if payments are not made in full, without the school's consent, will be considered unlawful appropriation of school property.
